


This technique has been developed by one of our great client (Sue). In order to help other cat owners Sue sent us this file describing the steps she used to be able to make her cat wear a Balto BT-SPLINT-XXS Carpal Brace. Thank you Sue!

1- Stick 3M double sided tape onto the inside of the brace.

2- Cut the bandage into appropriate size, then press the non-sticky side of bandage onto the 3M tape; Or, you can do it the other way around by sticking the bandage onto the cat's limb first.



3- Put the brace on (refer to Balto instructions on how to do that), and wrap Petflex.



^{*} I also sticked 2 bits of Velcro on the front side of her arm where the braces Velcro wraps. The bits can help to hold the braces Velcro in place to add more stability.

^{*} Since the brace is 'glued' to her limb, thus there's no need for it to get wrapped too tight.
